The entry fee is non-refundable. Invoice requests should be made by August 10, 2024. Players who have paid the entry fee and this fact is noted on the starting list do not need to confirm and can go directly to the first round.

Competition System and Time Control:

Swiss system over 9 rounds. The final standings are determined by:

1. Total points scored;
2. Buchholz Cut-1;
3. Buchholz;
4. Greater number of victories;
5. Direct encounter;
6. Sonneborn-Berger.

A maximum delay of 15 minutes is allowed for the round. A player is entitled to one half-point bye in rounds 1-5. This must be reported to the chief arbiter no later than the end of the last game of the previous round, and for the first round by August 23 at 18:00.

Remarks:

- Prizes up to 2000 PLN are tax-free.
- The tax on other prizes is 10%.
- Prizes over 1000 PLN (excluding OPEN C) will be paid by bank transfer within 7 days of the end of the competition.
- Prizes are not divisible.
- A player can receive a maximum of two prizes.
- If a player is eligible for more than two prizes, they will receive the two highest ones.
- If the values are the same, the order is: general classification, junior group (youngest possible), woman, lowest possible ranking group.
- Prizes for women in age groups and ranking groups will be awarded provided that there are at least 3 competitors in the group.
- To receive a prize, the player must be present at the Festival's closing ceremony.

Additional Information:

- The organizer reserves the right to make changes to the above announcement.
- Participants and accompanying persons must insure themselves at their own cost during the Festival.
- The organizer has the right to allow juniors and players who do not meet the ranking requirements to participate in the A and B tournaments.
- In case of high demand, the organizer reserves the right to move one of the tournaments to another playing hall.
- The final interpretation of the announcement belongs to the organizer.
